# Where does the metal you recycle end up?

**Put 2 extra cans into your blue-lidded recycling bin (or recycling bag if you live in an area where bags are used as an alternative) and you'll save enough energy to run a computer for up to 12 hours.**

Best of all, it doesn't take a lot to save enough energy to make a difference. Just drop your clean, empty cans, aerosols and foil into your blue-lidded recycling bin, not the rubbish bin. It's that easy.

## Do I need to clean them or take anything off?

All your cans, aerosols and foil need to be clean and empty. Wash and squash cans and foil. Remove lids but you don't need to remove any labels. Place clean, dry items loose into your blue-lidded recycling bin. Do not bag!

- ✓ Drink cans
- ✓ Food tins
- ✓ Pet food tins
- ✓ Foil and foil trays
- ✓ Empty aerosols
- ✓ Sweet and biscuit tins
