

What is the Cathedral Bus

The Cathedral Bus service links the railway station, principal city centre bus stops, Freeman's Place coach stop and the market place with the World Heritage Site of Durham Cathedral and Castle. There are also additional journeys between Durham Railway Station and Durham University Science Park during peak times.

Who can use the Cathedral Bus Service?

It is a normal public bus service, open to everyone. The buses have a step free entrance so are accessible for wheelchair users and people with pushchairs.

How much will it cost me?

- Tickets to travel on Cathedral Bus cost £1.00 adult, 50p for children aged 5 to 15 years and children under 5 go free. Tickets are valid all day with the exception of journeys to or from the university where a single journey fare of £1.00 (£1.50 return) applies.
- Concessionary passes are valid on this service.
- Holders of valid Park & Ride tickets or Explorer North East tickets can also travel for free.
