I, Colette Longbottom, the Returning Officer at the above parish poll, do hereby give notice of the number of votes recorded at the said parish poll.

The Question that has been put to the electors is as follows:

“Do you demand that the Town Council freezes the Town Council precept until 2020. That efficiency savings equating to 30% of the Town Council budget are made over the next 5 years. And that no future increase in precept of 2% or over can be made without a ‘yes’ vote from the referendum?”
