STATUTORY DECLARATION

SECTION 31 (6) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

I TIMOTHY JAMES COLLINGWOOD BARLING FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE NATIONAL TRUST FOR PLACES OF HISTORIC INTEREST AND NATURAL BEAUTY DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:

1. The National Trust is and has been since the 29 January 1943 the owner of the land known as Ebchester Woods, more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon edged red.
2. On the *Second* day of *August* 19*96* I deposited with Durham County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by a plan delineating my property by red edging which stated that the ways coloured yellow on the said plan and on the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as footpaths.
3. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land edged red on the plan accompanying this declaration since the statement dated *Second* day of *August* 19*96* referred to in 2. above.
